Declaration of Assets (State-Owned Enterprises) (Revocation) Regulations 2019

Following the promulgation of the Declaration of Assets (State-Owned Enterprises) Regulations 2019, this Office has received representations with regard to the implementation of these Regulations.

- 2. Cabinet has, at its meeting of 19 September 2019, agreed that the submission of declaration forms to the Independent Commission Against Corruption be effected in a phased manner. As such, the submission of the forms by the declarants from state-owned enterprises has been postponed to a later stage.
- 3. Accordingly, the Declaration of Assets (State-Owned Enterprises) Regulations 2019 has been revoked. A new regulation would be prescribed at a later stage.
- 4. In this connection, please find enclosed a copy of the Declaration of Assets (State-Owned Enterprises) (Revocation) Regulations 2019 (*GN No. 177 of 2019*) made by the Hon. Prime Minister under section 13 of the Declaration of Assets Act.
- 5. This Office will, in due course, issue a circular, requesting all Supervising Officers of Ministries/Departments to inform all State-Owned Enterprises, falling under their purview, of the revocation of the Declaration of Assets (State-Owned Enterprises) Regulations 2019.
