The Government of the Republic of Mauritius has received a Grant from the African Development Bank (“the Bank”) under the Middle-Income Country Technical Assistance Fund (MIC TAF) toward the cost of the Technical Assistance for Combatting Financial Crimes (TACFiC) Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Expressions of Interest is issued.
  2. The Financial Crimes Commission (FCC), one of the Beneficiary Agencies under the Project, intends to recruit a Short-Term Procurement Consultant to provide dedicated procurement support to the FCC in planning, managing and executing procurement processes including mainly the procurement of consultancy firm for development of the National Financial Crime Policy and Strategy (NFCPS) and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) under the TACFiC Project, in accordance with the African Development Bank's “Procurement Policy for Bank Group Funded Operations” (October 2015) and the provisions of the Financing Agreement. The duration of the assignment is estimated at six (6) months, based at FCC headquarters.
  3. The FCC now invites eligible individual consultants to submit their expression of interest in providing the above consultancy services.
